

Oklahoma Sexual Assault Statistics

- A total of 1,501 forcible rapes were reported to Oklahoma law enforcement agencies in 2003.
- According to the OSBI, only one in ten rapes is reported.
- Forcible rapes accounted for approximately 8.5% of all violent crimes.

Victims served in state annually: 2,000

Uniform Crime Data

Number of victims recorded 2005: 1,481

Forcible rape is defined by the FBI as “the carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will. Assaults and attempts to commit rape by force or threat of force are also included; however, statutory rape (without force) and other sex offenses are excluded”. This definition of rape is extremely limited, excluding male victims of sexual assault, incidents where physical force was not used, victims raped by family members, and only counting victims of vaginal/penile penetration.

About the Oklahoma Coalition Against Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault

What OCADVSA does: State Office staff work on various state level committees, task forces, councils and advisory boards as well as reach out to law enforcement, social services, medical and judicial systems, the government, and the private sector to develop and enhance knowledge and understanding of domestic and sexual violence. The State Office coordinates the bi-monthly meetings of the Steering Committee, conducts needs assessments of the service providers, maintains a resource library, publishes the Coalition newsletter, and participates with national coalitions and victim organizations. The Education division honors requests for training, education, and technical assistance and is instrumental in the planning and coordination of the State Conference, seminars, and training events. The State Office coordinates the annual day at the State Capitol, and Sexual Assault and Domestic Violence Awareness Month activities.
